The Queensland Orchestra's *The Club*

The Club program was originally designed to create partnerships between school communities and The Queensland Orchestra (TQO), where musicians and teachers work together to co-plan a unit of work or lessons.

The Club provides access to musical experiences that will encourage and support young people as creative artists, providing opportunities for them to develop their music making skills and foster current industry networks. The program also provides school communities with the opportunity to work directly with musicians from The Queensland Orchestra across a wide variety of musical instruments.

The program is designed for both instrumental and classroom music teachers in primary and secondary schools. Music teachers will co-plan with selected players from the orchestra to design a series of well-connected activities that will support and layer current classroom and instrumental programs including:

- a strategy for how and when the musician is involved with students
- what the content will be and what resources will be required
- what are the expectations of the musician
- what are the expectations of the teachers, students, parents, and principal.

The Club is flexible and exciting and provides Queensland students with real world musical experiences
